Groundwater remediation project for cleanup of a plume contaminated with hexavalent chromium, total chromium, selenium, molybdenum, and nitrates. Remediation would include construction of extraction, injection, and monitoring wells, as well as supporting infrastructure such as roads, utility connections, and pipelines. Project activities would be located within approximately 780 acres. Construction would occur for approximately 3 years. The treatment would occur for an estimated 29 years, but could be from 10 to 110 years. After cleanup goals have been achieved, all remediation infrastructure, including an existing groundwater treatment plant, would be decommissioned and removed.
